GENERAL GOING ABROAD QUESTIONS

- WHAT WOULD YOU DO DIFFERENTLY IF YOU CHOSE TO STUDY ABROAD AGAIN?
- WHAT DID YOU DO FOR YOUR FLIGHTS? DID YOU WORK WHILE STUDYING ABROAD?

- WHEN ARE THE FALL TERM DATES (SEPTEMBER-DECEMBER)? Semester dates differ per country and should be verified prior to submitting your application

- WHAT IS THE REGISTRATION PROCESS FOR THE EXCHANGE PROGRAM? Be sure to attend the mandatory CSEP information sessions prior to submitting your application! Below are the CSEP deadlines:

- * NEXT CSEP INFORMATION SESSION: OCTOBER 29 1:00PM
- * 2021-2022 ACADEMIC YEAR <u>OR</u> FALL 2021: FEBRUARY 1, 2021
- WINTER 2022: JUNE 1 2021

- SHOULD I TALK TO MY ACADEMIC ADVISOR TO AND PLAN MY COURSE SEQUENCE ACCORDING TO WHAT I COULD TAKE ABROAD? CAN I FINISH MY DEGREE ABROAD?

For questions about courses to take abroad, reach out to our CSEP coordinator Amanda Holt! It is not recommended to do your final semester abroad as it will delay your graduation since it can sometimes take up to a few months for Concordia to receive transcripts from your host institution.

GENERAL GOING ABROAD QUESTIONS

- WHICH UNIVERSITY IN EUROPE WOULD YOU RECOMMEND FOR AN ECONOMICS MAJOR? BEST FINA400 COURSES TO TAKE AT UNSW? HOW DO YOU GO ABOUT FINDING WHICH SCHOOL IS A GOOD FIT FOR YOU/WHICH ONE TO GO TO?

For course specific questions, feel free to reach out to our CSEP coordinator Amanda Holt

Read past exchange students' reports/watch their exchange videos to gain more perspective on your school/country of interest. You can also join the "JMSB CSEP go away!" Facebook page and reach out to students to ask them specific questions about their experience!

- IF I DO A SEMESTER AWAY, DOES IT PUSHES MY GRADUATION?

It depends on what courses you take abroad, and what the semester dates are.

- WHAT DO YOU DO IF YOU HAVE TO TAKE SUMMER CLASSES (BECAUSE OF COOP) BUT THE ACADEMIC YEAR IN THE EXCHANGE COUNTRY ENDS IN MID JUNE. IS IT JUST NOT AN OPTION OR CAN ACCOMMODATIONS BE MADE AT CONCORDIA?

You will have to speak with your Co-op coordinator but sometimes adjustments to your course sequence can be made as long as you stay within the co-op guidelines (ex. 3 consecutive work terms and graduating on a work term are not allowed)

BUDGET AND HOUSING QUESTIONS

- HOUSING OPTIONS?

Some universities offer on campus housing in dorms. If this is unavailable they sometimes provide a list of off-campus housing options that are not affiliated to the university.

- IS IT POSSIBLE TO HAVE ROOMMATES FROM CONCORDIA TO LOWER EXPENSES EVEN IF WE DON'T KNOW WHO WILL BE TRAVELING FROM CONCORDIA TO THE SAME LOCATION?

Join the "JMSB CSEP go away!" Facebook page to connect with other students studying abroad with you.

- HOW CAN WE APPLY TO THE FINANCIAL AID AND EVEN IF YOU ARE AN INTERNATIONAL STUDENT CAN WE APPLY?

Quebec mobility bursary (up to \$3000) for students studying abroad LOJIQ bursary is on a first come first serve basis!

- HOW DID YOU CREATE A BUDGET FOR YOUR EXCHANGE?

It is important that you verify the cost of living in the city where you'll be staying prior to your departure. Helpful information can be found at the following website: https://www.Numbeo.Com/cost-of-living/

WORKING ABROAD QUESTIONS

- HOW DO EXCHANGES WORK WITH THE CO-OP PROGRAM? CAN YOU APPLY TO DO AN INTERNSHIP ABROAD?

It is possible to do an exchange and/or internship abroad. All you have to do is submit your Co-op sequence application with the semester you would like to go on exchange, and get it approved by your Co-op Coordinator. Be sure to follow Co-op guidelines and plan ahead!

- WHERE CAN WE GO, WHAT ARE THE OPTIONS ?

Adjust your Co-op settings to gain access to international opportunities or search independently via Linkedin, Facebook etc.

COVID-19 RELATED QUESTIONS

- HOW IS GOING ABROAD HAPPENING WITH COVID-19?

You can still submit your application to study/work abroad! However, there are many things to take into consideration: whether the host institution is still accepting foreign students is up to to their discretion. Check the host country's COVID-19 guidelines prior to departure and be cautious before making any financial commitments.

- HOW GUARANTEED ARE WE TO STILL GO TO OUR CHOSEN LOCATION DUE TO COVID-19?

CSEP nominations are dependent on the requirements of the program/host institution.
